

## ***Driver Education at Fairmont Junior High School***

Some information regarding the policies and procedures to be followed in the Driver Education Program at Fairmont:

- This program is a part of the Driver Education Program offered by The Boise School District.

- Classroom instructor is Jeff Coe. In-car instructors are Jeff Coe and Rachel Brasil.
- Website for this program is <http://www.jeffcoedrivered.com> Your child's grades are posted on this website. Ask your child for their 4 digit password.
- Classes begin promptly at 3:30 and end promptly at 5:30 ... Tardiness is not permitted.
- All classes are mandatory. Absences are made up with a fee of \$30 per hour.
- Boise District policy, which meets or exceeds State of Idaho policy, is for each student to have a minimum of: 30 hours of classroom instruction ... 6 hours of behind the wheel instruction ... 11 hours of observation from the back seat ... The final 30 minute drive is with a parent in the back seat.
- Each of the student's twelve 30 minute drives will be graded. A passing grade for a drive is a B minus (80%). The State of Idaho requires that the twelve drives must average at least 80% in order to pass the course.
- All classroom tests, quizzes, assignments, and projects must be completed. The State of Idaho requires a classroom average of at least 80% in order to pass the course.
- The Driving grade AND the Classroom grade must **each** be at least 80% in order to pass the course.
- The student must demonstrate a positive and responsible attitude throughout the process of learning to drive. This is the third component of their assessment. A student will fail the class if they do not demonstrate a positive and responsible attitude.
- It is against the law to drive any private motor vehicle (cycles or cars) on public streets or roads during the driver education course. We are required by law to immediately drop from the course and fail any student driving without a valid Idaho Driver's License.
- **The Parent Class on 17 May requires at least one parent to be in attendance with their child ... Permits are distributed at the conclusion of this one hour class on 17 May.**
